## 2009 Follo and Superior Award Nomination Form

The Historical Society of Michigan presents the **Charles Follo Award** to an *individual* who has made an outstanding contribution to the preservation and promotion of the history of the Upper Peninsula. The award was established in 1979 to honor the memory of Charles Follo, a school teacher from Escanaba who was an ardent supporter and contributor to the work of historical societies in the UP. The presentation will be made at the annual Upper Peninsula History Conference.

The Historical Society of Michigan presents the **Superior Award** to an *historical organization* that has made an outstanding contribution to the preservation and promotion of the history of the Upper Peninsula. The award was established in 2006 to honor historical societies, museums, and other historical organizations in the UP for their efforts to advance UP history. The presentation will be made at the annual Upper Peninsula History Conference.

**Deadline for nominations is FRIDAY, May 1, 2009 at 5 PM.  
Materials must be RECEIVED by HSM by this time.**

### **Submission Requirements:**

1. This cover form fully completed.
2. A minimum 500-word narrative supporting the nomination. On a separate sheet of paper, please state the reasons for your nomination and provide a description of the individual or organization and the work done by them for the Upper Peninsula. The more complete the information provided, the better the HSM Awards Committee can evaluate the nominee.
3. Any supporting information such as clippings, photos, and letters of support.
4. **TEN (10) copies** of the nomination packet. The "nomination packet" includes all the items listed above and is used by the Awards committee to evaluate your entry. It includes ALL materials assembled for the nomination (cover form, nomination narrative, any supporting information). *Please use only 8.5x11" paper for your nomination packet materials.* Copies of any supporting samples (brochures, exhibit guides, etc) may also be attached to each packet.
5. Individuals currently serving on the Board of Trustees of the Historical Society of Michigan and have organizations in affiliation with are not eligible to receive this award.
