

Instructions for Electronic Access to the *Michigan Historical Review* for eligible HSM members

Electronic access is available for all membership categories except:

BASIC
BASIC ENHANCED
STUDENT

All current HSM members at a membership level that includes the *Michigan Historical Review* (MHR) have access to the journal online in electronic format as part of your membership through the journals involvement in the History Cooperative on-line network. This electronic access does NOT replace the paper copy which will be mailed to all eligible members semiannually. Below are instructions for INDIVIDUAL and somewhat different instructions for INSTITUTIONAL (Libraries and Museum) members on how to obtain access to the electronic back issues of the MHR from the History Cooperative:

INDIVIDUAL/FAMILY Members:

You can set up a personal account to access the *Michigan Historical Review* online. Simply register with the History Cooperative by using your membership ID number found above or as shown above your name on any recent issue of HSM's *Chronicle* magazine. Go to the account setup screen at www.historycooperative.org/adduser.php (If you have already use the History Cooperative's resources and have set up your personal account, you can go straight to the login screen at <http://www.historycooperative.org/login.html>.) Your membership ID number is only needed the first time you access the online edition as a way to authenticate your membership. During your first login or any time thereafter, you can set up a personal login and password for future access. Individual subscribers who have problems should contact HSM at hsm@hsmichigan.org.

INSTITUTIONAL (Library and Museum) members with multiple access terminals: (If you are an institution without IP access, please contact HSM for assistance.)

If you are connecting from an institution that currently is an HSM member you will automatically receive access to full online content to the *Michigan Historical Review*. This is enabled through the use of institutional IP number ranges and does not require your personal login. HSM Member institutions that are not immediately able to connect to the online version need to fill out the History Cooperative's Online IP Registration Form at www.historians.org/HistoryCoop/ which will add your institutional IP numbers to the History Cooperative's control system.
